D7: (Finish up Ch. 7 Quiz, Presentations, etc.) PBL Introduction: Students are given the overview of the entire assignment, from beginning to end. They are given Part V/ Final: Guided Tour Assignment (100 pts). They are encouraged to begin deciding which local community they want to research (somewhere close by, that they can easily get to) and create a tour for, and encouraged to work close to home. They are given the Part I: Journal Entry Assignment (60 pts total), and reminded that they should submit a journal entry for at least 8 of the 12 days that we work on this project.

Assigned: Part V / Final Guided Tour Assignment (100 pts); Part I: Journal Entry Assignment (60 pts)

D8: Students are reminded again about the entire **PBL Assignment,** and then they are allowed to **begin brainstorming** about the **community** they want to highlight, as well as the **sites they want to point out.** We go over the many **different categories** that they should consider as part of their tour (Historic, Econ, Natural, etc.)

Assigned: Students receive the Part IIA+B: Site Survey Assignments (90 pts total) (both due T2D15).

D9: Groups finalized, and students are reminded about completing **Part IIB Independent Site Survey Notes HW (45 pts)** (this will be **graded individually**, though groups can go together). Students as groups will **create a plan** for covering all 3 of the required site types for their guided tour.

D10: Field Trip to Downtown Springville, UT. Kids will fill out their Part IIA Site Survey Notes (45 pts) for Downtown Springville. Part IIB is to be completed as HW

D11: Students will make plans to finish their **Part IIB Site Survey Assignment**, which requires them to visit several different sites around their chosen community. Continued in-class research, planning, etc.

Assigned: Students receive Part IIIA Interview or Part IIIB Tangible Product (75 pts) work (due D19).

D12: We'll discuss how they might go about **conducting** an **interview**, and how they might use their **Part IIB Assignment** as a good opportunity to set up these interviews ©, or begin getting ideas for their **tangible** (if they choose that option). We'll also discuss the **Examples** of Tours: <u>SLC Downtown</u>,

D13: Due: students will be given time to call and schedule **interviews** with their parents and people related to the sites, or make plans to finish their **Part IIIA or B assignments**; work will continue on **PV**

D14: Review of Part III Assignments (drafts due next time); work day on Part V

D15: Due: Students will submit both the **Part IIA+B Assignments (90 pts total)** for review, fishbowl activity.

Work Day: remainder of class, students given time for their PBL Projects Parts III.

Assigned: 2nd to last part of the PBL, Part IV: Public Presentation Poster board (100 pts) (due T2D19)
